Maria came for her adult program for dyslexia this past summer. While here, she told me about her love and passion for raising money for cancer research and especially her positive experiences riding each year on the Empire State Ride, which goes from Battery Park to Niagara Falls and is over five hundred miles long. At the end of her weeklong, outside program, she and I, along with her partner, went for a long bike ride along the Hudson River, which is a few blocks from my office, Dyslexia Works New York. It was really fun and the perfect end for a very effective program week.

Her treatment started on November 29, and I was just so inspired and impressed with her poise and her calm. She wrote to me after her diagnosis, and we have exchanged messages ever since. About the Davis tools she received with the program, she has reported that she is using her tools regularly and that they are a real Godsend throughout her visits to doctors and during treatment.
